CARE Österreich underwent the EGSIM Strategical Appraisal and is accredited in the field of humanitarian aid for the implementation of humanitarian aid measures, by ADA. For this reason, no risk categorization by ADA is necessary.
5. Has the project encountered unexpected challenges? If yes, please explain.
The COVID crisis has been affecting work but was well managed (adaptive approaches, revised results framework; virtual monitoring visits); Teenage Pregnancies increased; In November 2021, CARE Uganda terminated the partnership agreement with PACHEDO (Gulu) due to fraud incidents. New Partner Thrive Gulu: has a focus on gender-based violence (GBV), particularly comprehensive support for survivors. They are known and active in relevant forums in Gulu. Key project staff and local structures (formerly of PACHEDO) have continued their work during the transition period and continue the work with the new organization Thrive, so that important knowledge is maintained. Thrive Gulu will therefore be able to implement activities in all four WAYREP Result Areas.
6. How do you assess perspectives for impact and sustainability of the intervention?
Sustainability can be definitively assessed after completion of the evaluation and submission of the final report.
