



# E-Learning Instruction

Before we start here are some **instructions** on how to use the e-learning tool.

We generally recommend using Microsoft Edge or Google Chrome, as the content is optimally displayed on these browsers.

Click on the arrows on the right or left side to switch to the next or previous slide. Alternatively, you can use the arrow keys on your keyboard. You can also use the chapter function in the upper left corner to choose a chapter or subchapter. You can interrupt the e-Learning whenever you want. Use the chapter function in the upper left corner to return to the chapter / slide you were in before.

In the lower left corner, you can track your learning progress. On the same bar on the right side, you can open further readings for additional material. You will find the references at the end of each module in the further readings. There you will also find the references at the end of each module.

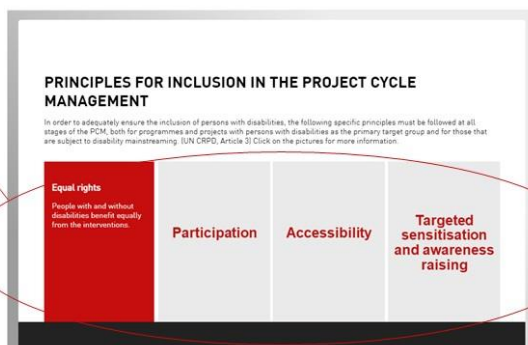

On some slides there are so-called learning cards. You can click on the cards to get more information. On other slides there are so-called hot spots. Click on the red bullets to get more information. A window will open in the lower left corner.
